Mr. Miller welcomed the residents to the meeting and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Branthoover introduced the individuals representing the Authority and explained the need for the line replacement areas – all or portions of Quaker Drive and Five Pines Road that are part of Penn's Woods Phase 4 and all or portions of Marcia Drive, Hedy Lynn Drive and Richard Road that are part of Markvue Manor Phase 1. Mr. Branthoover also touched on the lateral inspection program.

Engineer Dave Coldren had a PowerPoint presentation on the history of the Authority, scope of the project, present day challenges, required easements, restoration, private inflow and infiltration removal and the anticipated project schedule.

Mr. Sanner presented a video of a defective main sewer lines within the two project areas.

Mr. Branthoover, Mr. Miller, Mr. Coldren, Mr. Sanner, Mr. Henao and Attorney Hewitt answered questions.

Resident's questions related to a variety of topics –

- Getting in and out of driveways
- Restrictions on easements
- How backyards will be accessed
- How fences will be handled


After the adjournment residents also had an opportunity to meet with NHTMA staff to review the drawings as they pertained to their individual properties.
