Citizen's Input

There were no citizens present.

Update on Lateral Inspections

Mrs. Petrosky reported that 468 lateral inspections have been conducted on home sales and refinancings as of May 31, 2009, with 165 failures, or a 35% failure rate.

Norwin Soccer

Mrs. Petrosky brought the Board up-to-date on the situation with Norwin Soccer, and their sanitary sewer lateral.

Request from Mr. Menhart

Mrs. Petrosky reviewed the information received from MAWC, stating that the water service was terminated in August, 2008 at NHTMA's request due to non-payment. In addition, payments were received from the Menharts in 2007 and 2008, one accompanied by a payment stub, and one showing the account number, which indicates that they were receiving the invoices.

Consumption Billing

The Board reviewed Study #12 that was requested last month, with the goal of keeping the minimum bill near \$80, the maximum at \$300, maintaining average user rates at \$117.60, and generating sufficient overall revenue. Mr. Polczynski asked that the staff determine what revenue would be generated, using that study, for the overall
