The Work Session of the North Huntingdon Township Municipal Authority was called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Citizen's Input -- There were no citizens present.

Manager's Report

Mrs. Petrosky showed the Board a sample of the files that have been scanned into the computer system, such as property files, developer files, minutes, etc.

Mrs. Petrosky also provided the Board with an update of the Country Hills project and the securing of easements. Solicitor Snyder asked for guidance from the Board on filing condemnations separately or in a block, in the event this becomes necessary. The Board chose to file separately, based on the Solicitor's advice.

Mrs. Petrosky discussed hiring two temporary seasonal workers for summer work. This item is on the agenda for the regular meeting.

Mrs. Petrosky advised the Board that the Authority has received a request from Bill Hayward, who owns property on Coulterville Road in South Versailles, to tap a new home into the Authority's line.

Mrs. Petrosky reminded the Board that 2009 Statements of Financial Interest must be filed with the Township no later than May 1, 2010.

The Board discussed the emergency repairs undertaken on St. Clair Drive as a result of the pipe collapse. Ratification of the repair is on the agenda for the regular meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 6:30 PM, and the Board entered into an Executive Session to discuss two separate matters of litigation involving Glenn Engineering and WWMA, and to discuss a personnel matter.
