The Work Session of the North Huntingdon Township Municipal Authority was called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Citizen's Input -- There were no citizens present.

Manager's Report

Mrs. Petrosky reported that 863 lateral inspections have been conducted on home sales and refinancings as of January 31, 2010, with 299 failures, or a 35% failure rate. 227 tests have been completed in both project areas, with 136 failing (66%).

During January, 50 lien letter requests were received – 30 for sales, and 20 for refinancing. Six tap permits were issued, and 4 reinspection permits were issued.


The Authority staff continues to research options for accepting credit card payments at no cost to the Authority, as well as accepting online payments. The Board will be keep up-to-date as this research progresses.

Mrs. Petrosky discussed a proposal from Ryan Fonzi concerning the Authority's GIS system, and the Board suggested pursuing a shared-services agreement with the Township.

The Board went on to discuss the Reorganization.
