Monthly Rates, effective May 1, 2016

- NHTMA is funded through collection of monthly sewer service charges, currently at \$52.30 per month per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU). One EDU is equivalent to using 50,000 gallons of water per year.
- Residential premises are billed at a flat rate of \$52.30 per month.
- Non-residential premises are billed based on water consumption, with a minimum being \$52.30 per month.

Tap Fees, effective July 1, 2016

- The Authority charges a flat tap fee of \$3,950 for residential premises, and \$3,950 per EDU on non-residential premises.
