Tapping Fee Increase & Revised Developer Regulations

NHTMA tapping fees for new construction will increase to \$3,070 per EDU effective on all applications paid for on or after July 1, 2010.

This increase does not apply to tap fees that were **previously** prepaid as a result of tap restrictions. However, under revised regulations effective May 1, 2010, the Authority now requires a developer to pay a deposit for **all** required taps in a proposed plan, prior to approval. The deposit is based on the current cost per tap. However, in the event the tap fee increases before the actual tap permits are issued, the developer or owner must pay the difference between the tap fee deposit, and the current tap fee.
